Dr. Escotet to leave

DURANGO — Dr. Miguel A. Escotet will be leaving Durango shortly to assume duties as General Director for Research and Educational Planning for the country of Venezuela. Dr. Escotet is currently Associate Professor of Psychology at Fort Lewis College.

Dr. Escotet was educated in Spain and in South America, later receiving his Doctorate degree from the University of Nebraska. He joined the Faculty of Fort Lewis in 1972.
